The LO explained to the designee that it is an importance to get a qualified director in the facility as soon as possible.

The LO made a phone call to the supervisor. Per supervisor the facility must have everything submitted to the LO that is required to renew the license on or before May 30, 2019. A qualified director and a certified food manager should also be submitted to the LO on or before May 30, 2019. If documentation is not submitted to LO facility will be required to drop down to (5) five children on June 1, 2019.

Items Needed: Menus, Zoning letter, fire form, CPR-First Aid certificates (15) contact hours, food manager certification, director qualifications.

The LO did notice the some corrections made from the previous inspections as in Thermometer replace, hole in wall repaired, light bulbs
