Subchapter 8: Staffing

Deficiency: Rule 1.8.1 (2) children shall not be left unattended at any time. Video monitors cannot be used as a substitute for the physical presence of a caregiver in a room.

Findings: During walkthrough of facility, the facility failed to maintain staff-to-child ratio by leaving children unattended. There were 8 children alone in classroom 2 with no caregiver present.

POC: A caregiver from Room 4 came to Room 2 to cover the classroom. There was enough staff at the facility to adequately cover every classroom. (continued on page 2)

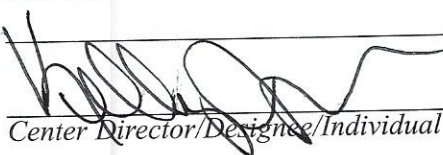
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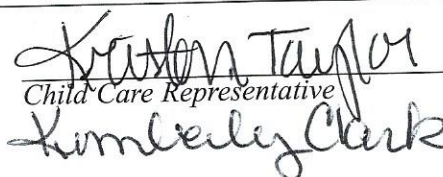
