Subchapter 8: Staffing

Deficiency: Rule 1.8.1(2) states in part, "Children shall not be left unattended at any time."

Findings: Based on observation while touring the facility, the facility failed to maintain staff-to-child ratio. One child was left unattended in the hallway bathroom with no caregivers present.

Plan of Correction

Region 1 Supervisor called the owner/director to the hallway bathroom. The owner/director escorted the child back to classroom.

Corrected on site.

Owner/director will have a staff meeting by Monday, March 21, 2022 informing all staff children cannot be left unattended at any time including sending children to the hallway bathroom.

Owner/director will submit meeting notes and a staff roster with signatures of staff to the Region 1 Supervisor by Monday, March 21, 2022 at 3:00 pm.

Class I and II violations could result in a monetary penalty. Repeated violations could result in the doubling of a monetary penalty, suspension, or revocation of license.
