- * During the previous visit the LO noticed the First Aid kit was not stocked with required items and that some items were expired.
- * During the follow-up LO observed that the First Aid kit has not been restocked, nor has the expired items been removed, nor has new kits been purchased. The Facility will have 5 days (11-1-19) to restock or purchase First Aid kits. * New & restocked items were added 8/19/19 *

Findings: During the Follow-up visit LO observed spaghetti with meat sauce, fruit cocktails, and bread being served with no vegetables. The menu posted was for the month of August. The owner presented a menu for this week while LO was still in the facility, green peas was on the menu, however when asked why green peas wasn't served the owner stated that the children wouldn't eat them.

Technical Assistance provided that just because children won't eat certain items is no reason that those items can be withheld, because some children just might eat it. The owner ~~voiced~~ ^{on} voiced understanding. TA also provided on what to do if items has to be substituted on the menu. LO explained that the item substituted must be noted on the menu.

Subchapter 11: Buildings and Grounds

Deficiency: Rule 1.11.5(4) "All hand washing lavatories shall have both hot and cold running water."

During the previous visit there was no hot water observed in any of the classrooms during the last inspection and there is still no hot water in any of the classrooms during this follow-up. The director called a plumber while LO was still in the facility and will submit a work order to LO by 10/31/19.

TA ~~on~~ TA provided regarding sanitation in the kitchen, when pest are evidence. During observation a dead pest was observed on the counter, however, it was removed but not sanitized properly.
