This violation also occurred on 11/18/2022, this was also self-reported by the facility. Both occurrences have occurred during the same licensing year.

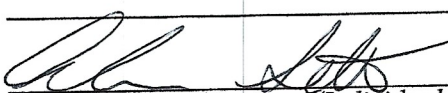
Plan of Correction:

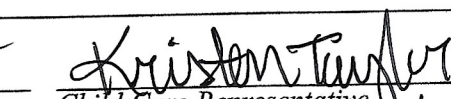
The owner has agreed to stop transporting children until September 30, 2024. A restricted license will be issued April 3, 2023 - Restriction will state on license cannot transport children except in emergency situations.

If no class I violations are cited for children being unattended during this 18 month period, the facility could be issued a regular license on October 1, 2024 and allowed to transport children.

Effective April 3, 2023 the facility will no longer transport children except in emergency situations. B

This was discussed with the owner and given the opportunity to ask any questions. The owner agreed to the restriction and to the restricted license. B
