(Rule 1.9.6 Page 42)
- 2. **Out of Compliance:** Outdoor activity is scheduled for a minimum of two hours per day, weather permitting. Children who attend for seven hours a day or less have at a minimum of 30 minutes of outdoor activity, weather permitting. (Rule 1.9.5 Page 42)
