Findings/Comments

Upon arrival licensing official met with Designee. Owner/Director arrived during visit.

The purpose of this visit was to follow up with provider concerning email request for time to make repairs at facility.

Licensing official observed air inoperable in First building upstairs. Second building air is inoperable throughout facility.

Licensing official informed owner she could not operate facility without air.

Ratio observed is as follow

Room 6 One year - 4 year 1 Staff 1 Volunteer 3 children
Room 5 School Age 2 Staff 12 children

The facility is prohibited to service only school age children until a MSPDH representative comes out to approve buildings.

Provider had to call parents to pick up children. Three Rule 1.4.4- Facility failed to inform licensing agency of changes at facility. No air.

While at facility parents were dropping children off. Licensing Official observed parents not signing children in. Designee stated she signs the children in. Technical Assistance was provided by licensing official informing staff parents should be required to sign their children in and out. If adequate staffing is available staff receiving children can provide sign in sheet to parent outside.

It was also observed that a parent dropped children off in street. Licensing official told staff this was not acceptable and then staff told parent she had to pull in drive way. But by then the children had already walked up sidewalk to building. Providers must follow approved arrival departure procedures, Rule 1.4.1 (2a-b)

Rule 1.11.8 (2) Facility failed to be adequately ventilated, cooled for children. Parents were called to pick up children because the air was out in buildings. Air is operable in two spaces front office of 2nd building and downstairs room in 1st building for afterschoolers/school age. Provider is only allowed to service school age/afterschool children until MSDH staff returns to approve buildings for infants, toddlers, preschoolers.

Provider had one volunteer present. Facility failed to have required documents for volunteer Rule 1.6.6 (1-4) Licensing Official informed provider volunteer shall not return until all documents are in

Provider mentioned investigator came out on an investigation on staff asleep in room during naptime while suppose to be supervising children.

It was told to licensing official Designee was in doorway on her break while the other staff of break room was asleep in the classroom with children. Staff asleep had taken medication and fallen asleep per Director.
