Findings/Comments Here for a follow up/technical assistance inspection.

The licensing official met with one of the directors upon arrival.

Caregiver #1 Fingerprints were bad and a name check is being conducted.

Caregiver #2 Fingerprints were bad and new fingerprints were to be re-submitted within 10 days of letter from the fingerprint unit. Letter from Fingerprint Unit was dated July 30, 2019. - Prints have been resubmitted.

Caregiver #3 cleared on April 25, 2017.

- A caregiver/staff member cannot be left alone with children. Rule 1.5.2 and Rule 1.6.4

Rule 1.6.3(5) cited on May 29, 2019 and July 17, 2019 has not been corrected. June, July, and August fire/disaster drills have not been conducted or documented.

Plan of Correction

The licensing official requested a fire/disaster drill to be conducted. Drill began at 8:46 and ended at 8:49, drill duration 2 minutes and 55 seconds

The two directors went down the hall knocking on doors saying "fire, fire". The licensing official recommends a whistle or horn to be purchased to alarm all staff members of all drills.

The licensing official observed 2 classrooms that did have a children's roster with the caregivers to ensure each child present made it out of the facility. The licensing official informed the directors that all caregivers/staff members are to have a hard copy of the children's roster that is present each day to ensure each child makes it out of the facility.

All fire/disaster drills will be conducted by the 5th of each month until December 2019. Starting in January 2020, fire/disaster drills can be conducted after the 5th of the month.

The licensing official will return to ensure fire/disaster drills are being conducted by the 5th of each month until December 2019. PS AM

Class I and II violations may result in a monetary penalty. Repeated violations may result in the doubling of a monetary penalty, suspension, or revocation of license.
