The owner of the facility can send the licensing official a letter or email documenting 2 years paid work experience at Little Sprouts #6917; documenting start date to present.

Caregiver #1 start date on employee application is July 12, 2017. Caregiver #1 needs 7 more months of documented work experience in a licensed child care facility.

Caregiver #2 has a high school transcript, regulations training, playground safety training, director's training, and hire/start date on employee application is September 20, 2016; a little over 2 years work experience.

Technical Assistance

#1 Snacks/meals being transferred from building #1 to building #2 will individual prepared and wrapped with Saran/Plastic wrap or aluminum foil. The plates cannot be stacked on top of each other.

option #2- Snacks/meals will be transferred from building #1 to building #2 in big pans and the individual plates will be prepared at building #2.
