Technical Assistance

Subchapter 5: Personnel Requirements

Rule 1.5.4 states in part, "Caregivers shall be at least 18 years of age."

Rule 1.5.5 states in part, "Caregiver assistants shall be at least 16 years of age. They shall not have the direct responsibility for a group of children as the sole caregiver."

Class I and II violations may result in a monetary penalty. Repeated violations may result in the doubling of a monetary penalty, suspension, or revocation of license.
