Findings/Comments Upon arrival LO met w/ Cynthia Jackson, director designee.

The purpose of this visit is to conduct a follow-up from the midyear visit on 7.12.2019 w/ the air not working. Facility received a clearance letter for the staff that didn't have one at the midyear inspection on 7.12.2019. The letter was cleared on 7.15.2019.

Ratio was in total compliance.

There were 7 afterschoolers in the back room w/ fans going. The temp of that room was 80° (Preschool Room). The designee moved the children to the front of the room where the unit (air) was. The children were moved there due to the LO arriving.

In the middle afterschool room there were 5 preschoolers in that room. The temp in that room was 78°. The air from the front room was blowing in the afterschool room (middle). LO placed the thermometer from the front room to get the temperature because no thermometer was present in that room.

In the bottom afterschool room there were 6 afterschoolers in that room. The LO moved the thermometer in that room as well because no thermometer was present.

The designee called her contractor on the phone while LO was present and asked him to put air unit in the two rooms where the temp was up at.

The children in the back room were moved back to the front room while LO was present.

On 7.12.2019 rule 1.11.8 was cited.

Subchapter 11: Building & Grounds

Deficiency: Rule 1.11.8(9) States "Thermometers That do not present a hazard to the children shall be placed on interior walls in every activity area at childrens height.

Findings: Based on observations, while touring the facility LO observed no thermometers posted in 2 rooms utilized by children. Designee stated that the thermometer was purchased at Lowes and they were left in her daughters car. (which is the director) Designee called someone to bring thermometer so that she can put them up. LO explained to the designee that the thermometers should have been posted the day after the midyear inspection. The thermometers were brought to the facility at 10:30am and the designee posted them immediately.

At 10:40am the men that are going to put the air units in arrived. While LO was at the facility the air units were being put in the windows,
